

"Our May 14th's sermon on *Places and Faces of Faith* brought us to Athens, first city of the mind in the Greco-Roman world. Our May 21st sermon takes us to Jerusalem. One might call it the city of faith, as Jerusalem is sacred to three world-wide faiths. Or one might see Jerusalem as the realm of the heart, but not just any heart: a passionate heart, a devoted, dedicated, fervently committed heart for God. Such places are dangerous. A heart or a religion gone wrong can go very wrong. Jerusalem has seen a lot of faith gone wrong.

But Sunday's scripture from *John 17*, takes us to the heart of faith and love going right. Hours before Christ's crucifixion, John allows us to read and hear what Jesus prays. He prays. . .for God's glory. . .and for his disciples in the Upper Room. . .and Jesus prays for us. What if we understood ourselves as a people for whom Christ prays? What if we understood all people as those for whom Christ prays? Now. Always. What do we learn as Jesus prays for us all, that 'they may be one, even as I and the Father are one?'" -Mike


